First Grade SUPPLIES

This is a list of the supplies that your child will need for First Grade. Please have these items for the first week of school labeled with your child's first and last name.

School Bag (Regular size, no wheels please!)

Please make sure your child's lunch is in a lunch bag with his/her name on it and snack is in a brown paper bag every day labeled "snack". Drinks should be able to fit in their lunch bag as a safety precaution when walking to and from the lunchroom. Also, please make sure they have a drink for lunch as well as during snack.

*No metal canisters are allowed.

1 pencil pouch* -*Please have their pencil pouch filled with the following supplies: 2 pencils, eraser, glue stick, scissor and a pack of 24 crayons**

Contact paper (Keep Home - Please have this available at home for the first week of school and the remainder of the year. You will need to cover your child's workbook/notebooks as they come home with them, we suggest you purchase more than one roll as there will be multiple books that will have to be covered throughout the year)

2 roll of paper towels

2 box of tissues

3 package of baby wipes

Art Shirt* - Please make sure that the shirt is large enough to fit over their uniform to prevent them from getting their uniform dirty. Please be sure to print your child's name on it in permanent marker. (This is not on School Tool Box)

1 boxes of 24 Crayola crayons (regular size, no big crayons please)

5 plastic two-pocket folders in the following colors: yellow, red, blue, green and purple.

4 large glue sticks

1 liquid "Elmer's" glue.

2 boxes of #2 Sharpened Pencils supp

1 ream of copy paper

1 ream of card/cover stock paper

1 safety scissor

2 clorox wipes

1 large box of zip locs (gallon size)

1 small box of zip locs (quart size)

1 Composition Book (Wide Ruled)-Black Marble 100 count

1 Primary Composition/Journal book -top ½"ruling, ¼" skip line.
